

## CHAPTER VI

### SOCIO ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

#### 6.1 INTRODUCTION

The data collected on various parameters of socio-economic conditions of Scheduled Tribe Workers in the Scheduled Tribe belt of Gujarat State consisting of four strata. Viz, Vapi, Valsad, Navsari and Sachin, like income, earning strength, expenditure, possession of durable goods and live stock, assets, indebtedness, housing conditions, migration, attitude towards customs faith and beliefs etc. have been analyzed in the following paragraphs.

## **6.2 FAMILY INCOME AND RECEIPTS**

Information on income is collected to facilitate study of the level and pattern of income by source, to study the expenditure pattern in relation to income and in general to provide a basis for classifying families into economic level. Income for the purpose of the survey is taken to include all receipts, such as receipts from paid employment, which include basic wages and allowances, bonus and commissions, overtime earnings, concessions and other benefits; net income from self employment, such as boarding and lodging services, agriculture, animals husbandry, trade, profession etc and net income from rented property, viz land, house, income from pension, cash assistance, gift/concessions, interests and dividends and chance games.

The value of receipts in kind and of goods from family enterprises consumed by the family is imputed on the basis of prevalent retailed market prices.

### **6.3 INCOME AND FAMILY SIZE**

Table 6.1 depicts the percentage distribution of sample Scheduled Tribe families by family income for four strata viz. Vapi, Valsad, Navsari and Sachin.

In Vapi, around 64 per cent of families have three to five members, followed by 25 per cent families having six to eight members. The percentage of families having one member and two members is around 4 per cent each, whereas the percentage of families with nine members and more are about 3 per cent. Maximum of families around 30 per cent have monthly income of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, among them about 72 per cent families have three to five members, about 24 per cent families, who have monthly income of Rs.4000 to less than Rs.6000, out of these about 70 per cent families have three to five members. Only around 10 per cent of families have monthly income of Rs.8000 and above, whereas the minimum percentage i.e. 1.3 per cent families fall in the monthly family income class of less than Rs.1000 and Rs.1000 to less than Rs.1500.

In Valsad stratum, around 70 per cent of families have three to five members, followed by 25 per cent of families having six to eight members. Families having one member and two members is about 1 per cent each, while families with nine and more members are around 3 per cent. The maximum of families i.e. 31 per cent had monthly family income of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, out of which about 82 per cent families have three to five members. Around 30 per cent of families have monthly income of Rs. 4000 to less than Rs.6000, out of which 66 per cent families have three to five members. Around 10 per cent of families have monthly income of Rs.8000 and above, whereas the minimum percentage i.e. 0.6 per cent families falls in the monthly family income class of less than Rs.1000.

In the Navsari stratum around 74 per cent of families have three to five members, followed by around 19 per cent families having six to eight members.

The percentage of families with two members is about 4 per cent while the percentage of families having one member and nine and more members is around 2 per cent each. The maximum proportion i.e. 27 per cent families have monthly family income of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, out of which about 80 per cent families belong to the family size class of three to five members; about 25 per cent of families fall in the monthly family group of Rs.1500 to less than Rs.2500, out of which about 89 per cent families belong to the family size class of three to five members. Around 13 per cent families have monthly family income of Rs.8000 and above. The minimum proportion i.e. 2.7 per cent belongs to the family income class of less than Rs.1000.

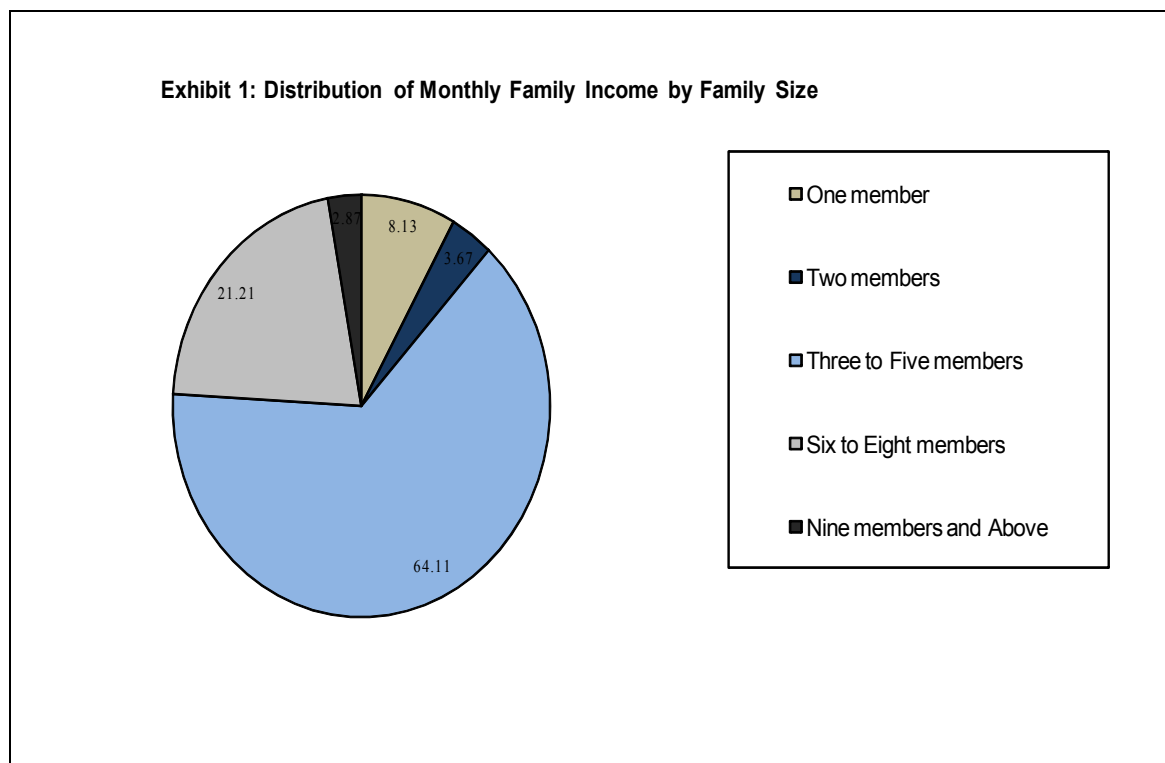
In Sachin, as in the case of other strata around 47 per cent families have three to five members followed by 34 per cent families having one member. The percentage of families with two members, six to eight members and nine and more members are about 7 per cent, 9 per cent and about 3 per cent respectively. Around 30 per cent families, have monthly family income of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, out of which about 49 per cent families belong to the family size of three to five members where as about 39 per cent families has single member. About 23 per cent of families have monthly family income of Rs.1500 to less than Rs.2500, out of which 46 per cent and 42 per cent have three to five members and one member families respectively. About 13 per cent families have monthly family income of Rs.8000 and above.

At aggregate level about 64 per cent of families have three to five members, followed by about 21 per cent families with six to eight members. The proportion of families having one member, two members and nine members and above is about 8 per cent, 4 per cent and 3 per cent respectively.

More than 30 per cent of families have monthly income of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, whereas the monthly income of about 23 per cent families is Rs.4000 to less than Rs.6000. About 19 per cent families have monthly income of Rs.1500 to less than Rs.2500 whereas about 22 per cent families have

monthly income of Rs.6000 and more. The minimum percentage i.e. 2.1 per cent families have been reported in the lowest income class of less than Rs.1000.

The graphic presentation distribution of families by family size and monthly income group for combined strata is presented below:



#### **6.4 EARNING STRENGTH AND INCOME CLASSES**

Table 6.2 shows the percentage distribution of sampled Schedule Tribe families by earning strength and monthly family income classes in the Scheduled Tribe belt of Gujarat.

In the Vapi stratum maximum families i.e. 52 per cent have single earner, followed by 32 per cent families having two earners and about 8 per cent have three earners. About 5 per cent families have one earner and one or more earning dependents. Around 32 per cent of families belong to the monthly family income class of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, 23.5 per cent belong to the

monthly family income class of Rs.4000 to less than Rs.6000, while 13 per cent of families belong to monthly family income class of Rs.6000 to less than Rs.8000, the percentage of families in the income class of Rs.8000 and above is 10 per cent. All the families in the lowest income class of less than Rs.1000 and Rs.1000 to less than Rs.1500 have one earner each and in the highest income class of Rs.8000 and more, about 22 per cent, 48 per cent and 17 per cent families have one earner, two earners and three earners respectively.

In Valsad stratum about 35 per cent of the total families have one earner, 29.9 per cent have two earners and 12.6 per cent have three earners. Further, about 11 per cent and 6 per cent families have one earner and one or more earning dependents, two earners and two or more earning dependents respectively. About 31 per cent of families belong to the monthly family income class of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000. The percentage of families those have monthly income of Rs.6000 to less than Rs.8000 and 8000 and more is about 14 per cent and 10 per cent respectively. Among the lowest income class of less than Rs.1000 and Rs.1000 to less than Rs.1500, families have one earner only, while the families in the highest income class of Rs.8000 and more, 18.7 per cent families have two earners, where as around 38 per cent of families have three earners, the percentage of families having two earners and one or more earning dependents is 18.7 per cent and more than three earners with or without earning dependent is 12.5 per cent.

In Navsari stratum about 42 per cent of families have one earner, 20 per cent have one earner and one or more earning dependents, 19 per cent have two earners whereas about 6 per cent have two earners and one or more earning dependents, while about 11 per cent families have three earners. The percentage of three earners and one or more earning dependents and more than three earners with or without earning dependents are 0.9 per cent and 1.8 per cent respectively. The highest proportion of families i.e. 27 per cent belong to the monthly income class of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, followed by the families with 25.2 per cent in the monthly family income class of Rs.1500 to less than

Rs.2500. The minimum proportion i.e. 2.7 per cent fall in the monthly family income class of less than Rs.1000 have one earner only. Among the families which fall in the monthly income class of Rs.1500 to less than Rs.2500, the maximum i.e. about 64 per cent have one earner, 11 per cent have one earner and one more earning dependents, 21 per cent have two earners and about 4 per cent have two earners and one or more earning dependents. In the highest income class of Rs.8000 and above, about 29 per cent each families have one earner and three earners respectively.

As regards, Sachin stratum, the maximum proportion of families i.e. about 67 per cent have single earner, 20.7 per cent have two earners and 6.3 per cent have three earners. About 3 per cent families each have one earners and one or more earner dependents and two earners and one or more earning dependents. Around 30 per cent families belong to monthly family income class of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, which have about 61 per cent families with single earner. About 23 per cent families fall in the monthly family income class of Rs.1500 to less than Rs.2500, among them 92 per cent families have single earner. In the lowest income class of less than Rs..1000 and Rs.1000 to less than Rs.1500, all families have single earner, while in the highest income class of Rs.8000 and more, about 43 per cent families have one earner, and 21.4 per cent each have two and three earners.

At aggregate level, the maximum proportion of about 48 per cent families have one earner, about 27 per cent families have two earners and about 10 per cent families have three earners. The minimum proportion worked out to be one per cent for families having three earners and one or more earning dependents. More than 30 per cent of families fall in the monthly family income of Rs.2500 to less than Rs.4000, out of which more than 58 per cent families have single earner, about 23 per cent families belong to the monthly income group of Rs.4000 to less than Rs.6000, out of which 46 per cent families have two earners. In the lowest income group of less than Rs.1000, all families have

single earner whereas the proportion of families i.e. about 11 per cent is reported in the highest income class of Rs.8000 and more.

## **6.5 AVERAGE MONTHLY FAMILY INCOME BY SOURCE AND CATEGORY OF EARNERS**

Table 6.3 reveals the average monthly income per family by source and category of earners.

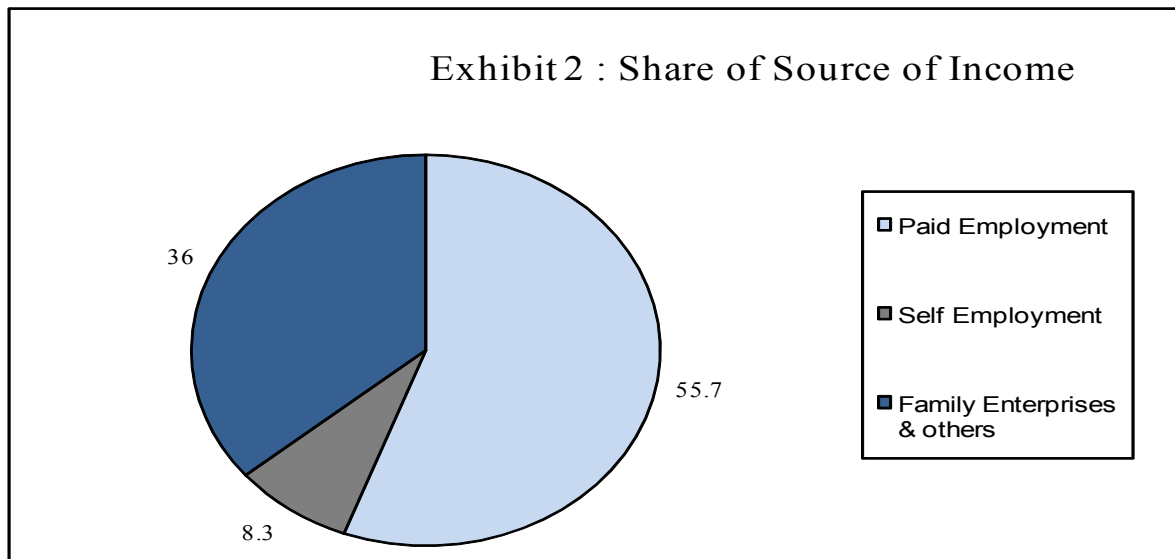
In Vapi Stratum, taking all sample households together, the average monthly income per household worked out to be Rs.5476.56 of which Rs.4490.68 (82 per cent) accrued from the paid employment, Rs.54.62(1.0 per cent) from self employment and Rs.931.26 (17.0 per cent) from the family enterprises and other family receipts. About 74 per cent (Rs.4074.32) of the average monthly income per household is contributed by men, about 9 per cent (Rs.470.98) by women and the remaining (Rs.931.26), 17 per cent income is contributed by family enterprises (in which some of the family workers worked) and other family receipts.

In Valsad stratum, taking all the sample households together, the average monthly income per household is worked out to be Rs.8265.40, of which Rs.4536.97 (54.9 per cent) is accrued from paid employment, Rs.161.38 (1.9 per cent) from self-employment and Rs.3567.05 (43.2 per cent) from the family enterprises and other family receipts. About 46 per cent (Rs.3797.46) of the average monthly income per household is contributed by men, 11 per cent (Rs.900.89) by women and the remaining 43.2 per cent (Rs.3567.05) income is contributed by family enterprises & other family receipts.

In Navsari, taking all the sample households together, the average monthly income per household is worked out to be Rs.8705.99 of which Rs.4323.13 (49.7 per cent) is accrued from paid employment, Rs.90.99 (1.0 per cent) from self-employment and Rs.4291.87 (49.3 per cent) from family

enterprises and other family receipts. About 43 per cent (Rs.3712.04) of the average monthly income per household is contributed by men, about 8 per cent (Rs.702.08) by women and the rest 49 per cent income is contributed by family enterprises and other family receipts.

In Sachin stratum, by taking all sampled household together, the average monthly income per household is worked out to be Rs.6781.05, of which Rs.4076.73 (60.1 per cent) is accrued from paid employment, Rs.65.76 (1.0 per cent) from self-employment and Rs.2638.56 (38.9 per cent) from family enterprises and other family receipts. About 58 per cent (Rs.3932.95) of the average monthly income per household is contributed by the men, about 3 per cent (Rs.209.55) by women and remaining 39 per cent (Rs.2638.56) income is contributed by family enterprises and other family receipts.



At the aggregate level, taking all the strata together it is observed that the average monthly income per household is worked out to be Rs.7022.01, of which Rs.4400.06 (62.7 per cent) is accrued from paid employment, Rs.91.46 (1.3 per cent) is from self employment and Rs.2530.49 (36.0 per cent) from family

enterprises and other family receipts. About 56 per cent (Rs.3911.41) of the average monthly family income per household is contributed by men, out of which 98 per cent of income is from paid employment and remaining 2 per cent from self-employment. Similarly, out of the 8 per cent (Rs.580.11) monthly family income per household is contributed by women, about 97 per cent of income is from paid employment and about 3 per cent from self employment. Out of the total 36 per cent (Rs.2530.49) of income from family enterprises, the percentage of income from family enterprise itself and other family receipts is 13 per cent and 87 per cent respectively. Exhibit below shows average monthly income per Scheduled Tribe family by source of income for the combined strata.

## **6.6 HOUSEHOLD CONSUMPTION EXPENDITURE**

Information on consumption expenditure is collected for the calendar month preceding the date of survey. Expenditure on various items like, food, clothing, shelter, fuel and light, education, transport, medical, personal effects etc. constitute the household consumption expenditure. Table 6.4 presents the average monthly per family consumption expenditure, as well as per capita expenditure of Scheduled Tribe Households. Further, because of the problem to recall lapse on the part of informants, it is always not possible to match income and expenditure of surveyed families. It is on account of this reason that some marginal gaps in the income and Expenditure have been left.

In Vapi stratum, the average monthly consumption expenditure per family is worked out to be Rs.4243.07 and the per capita consumption expenditure is Rs.885.06. Out of the total expenditure incurred, about 40 per cent of consumption expenditure is on food, 19.5 per cent on clothing bedding and footwear, about 10 per cent is on personal and household effects, 8 per cent on transport and communication, whereas about 7.3 per cent of expenditure is on fuel and light and 6 per cent on education and recreation.

In Valsad stratum, the average monthly consumption expenditure per family is worked out to be Rs.7453.46 and the per capita consumption

expenditure is Rs.1503.29. Out of the total expenditure incurred, about 27 per cent each of expenditure is on food and clothing, bedding and footwear, about 7 per cent each of medical care and personal households and effects, 6.4 per cent on fuel and light, while the expenditure on education is quite meagre i.e. 1.3 per cent only.

In Navsari, the average monthly consumption expenditure per family is worked out to be Rs.4856.38 and the per capita consumption expenditure is Rs.1050.80. Out of the total consumption expenditure, about 48 per cent is on food, 12.6 per cent on clothing, bedding and footwear, the expenditure on personal household effects is about 11 per cent, whereas the expenditure on education, fuel and light and on intoxicants is worked out to be 3 per cent, 6.6 per cent and 3 per cent respectively.

In Sachin, the average monthly consumption expenditure is worked out to be Rs.3191.23 and the per capita consumption expenditure is Rs.1000.64. Out of the total consumption expenditure, about 44 per cent is on food, 16.7 per cent on clothing, bedding and footwear, about 6 per cent each on transport and communication and personal household effects, while about 3 per cent each on education and on rent is reported.

At aggregate level, the average monthly consumption expenditure is worked out to be Rs.5020.51 and the per capita consumption expenditure is Rs.1109.97. Out of the total consumption expenditure, about 37 per cent of expenditure is on food, about 21 per cent on clothing, bedding and footwear, 6.7 per cent on fuel and light, 5.6 per cent on transport & communication, 4.6 per cent on medical care, whereas the expenditure on personal and household effects and education is 8.4 per cent and 2.6 per cent respectively.

## **6.7 POSSESSION OF DURABLE GOODS AND LIVE STOCK**

Durable goods, both essential and luxury items possessed by a family reflects the level of living of a family. Details regarding percentage distribution of Scheduled Tribe families by number of durable goods and livestock possessed

and the average number of durable goods and livestock per reporting family has been presented in the Table 5.5.

The survey results reveal that in Vapi stratum, more than 40 per cent of families have tables, about 80 per cent have chairs, about 93 per cent are having cots, whereas the big box is possessed by about 49 per cent of families, sofa and double bed each is possessed by 6.7 per cent only.

90 per cent and 46 per cent families possess electric fan and electric iron respectively. About 92 per cent of household families have clock/wrist watches; kerosene stove is possessed by more than 50 per cent of families whereas the Gas stove is used by only 35 per cent of families, about 70 per cent of families reported use of pressure cooker, while refrigerator is used by 10 per cent of families only.

Radio/transistor, television and tape recorder are possessed by about 32 per cent, 53 per cent and about 19 per cent of families, respectively. Bicycle, scooter/motorcycle/moped are possessed by about 86 per cent and 23 per cent respectively. More than 93 per cent of families have reported use of steel, aluminum, tin/iron and plastic utensils, while 83 per cent of families made use of brass utensils and 81 per cent are using earthenwares. About 12 per cent families rear cow/buffalo and about 11 per cent poultry.

In Valsad, about 68 per cent of families have tables, 90 per cent chairs and more than 92 per cent of families are having cots. 66.4 per cent families own Almirah, while about 11 per cent families own sewing machine. Double bed and diwan is owned by 22.2 per cent & 17.3 per cent of families respectively.

91 per cent and 25 per cent of families own electric fans and electric iron respectively. Almost 97 per cent of families have clock/wrist watches, kerosene stove, gas stove and pressure cooker are owned by about 38 per cent, 35 per cent and 56 per cent families respectively, while refrigerator is owned by about 11 per cent families only.

Radio/Transistor, Television, Tape recorder items are possessed by 31 per cent, 56 per cent and around 18 per cent of families respectively, whereas Bicycle and Scooter/Motor Cycle/Moped are owned by about 78 per cent and 29 per cent of families. All the families have steel utensils, while aluminum and earthenwares are possessed by more than 92 per cent of families; brass utensils are owned by about 60 per cent of families. About 11 per cent families rear cow/buffalo and poultry by 3 per cent only.

In Navsari it is observed that table is owned by about 45 per cent of families, whereas chairs are owned by about 86 per cent of families. About 92 per cent are having cots; about 54 per cent and about 48 per cent of families own almiraha and big box respectively.

Electric fans are owned by about 90 per cent families, while electric heater is owned by about 2 per cent only, whereas clock/time-piece/wrist watch are possessed by 76.6 per cent and kerosene stove/gas stove are owned by 23.4 per cent families, pressure cooker is owned by more than 50 per cent of families.

Radio/Transistor, Tape recorder, Television is possessed by 33.3 per cent, 24 per cent and 59 per cent families respectively. 85 per cent and 22 per cent families maintain bicycle and scooter/motor cycle/moped. Almost all families have steel utensils, 62.2 per cent families have aluminum utensils and about 77 per cent families own plastic utensils. About 6 per cent families rear cow/buffalos while about 3 per cent families rear goat.

In Sachin, 21 per cent families reported having tables and around 55 per cent families are having chairs. Cots are possessed by about 76 per cent families, sofa and double bed each is owned by 4.5 families.

Electric fan, Electric iron and Electric heater are owned by about 77 per cent, 22 per cent and 0.9 per cent respectively, whereas clock/time piece/wrist watches are owned by 81 per cent families, Kerosene stove, Gas stove and pressure cooker are owned by 59 per cent, 23 per cent and 56 per cent respectively. Refrigerator is possessed by only 5.4 per cent of families.

Radio/Transistor, Television, Tape Recorder are owned by about 41 per cent, 36 per cent and 10 per cent families respectively. 50 per cent and Scooter/Motorcycle/Moped by about 15 per cent family's own bicycle. More than 90 per cent families have steel aluminum, Tin/Iron and plastic utensils for their use; while Earthen and brassware are used by about 87 per cent and 50 per cent of families. About 9 per cent families rear cow/buffalo, while poultry by 4.5 per cent of families.

Taking all strata together, the survey results reveal that tables, chairs cots and almirahs are owned by 45 per cent, 79 per cent, 89 per cent and 50 per cent families respectively. Whereas sofa and double bed are owned by 6 per cent & 11 per cent families, sewing machine and refrigerator, each only 8 per cent families. 88 per cent and 31 per cent of families possess electric fan and electric iron. Clock/time piece/wrist watch, Kerosene stove, Gas stove and pressure cooker are maintained by about 89 per cent, 44 per cent, 31 per cent and 60 per cent families respectively. Radio/Transistor, Television, Tape recorder, are owned by 33 per cent, 52 per cent and about 18 per cent families respectively, while 0.5 per cent and 0.8 per cent families maintain harmonium and dholak/tabla. Bicycle, Scooter/Motor cycle/Moped are maintained by 77 per cent and 23 per cent families. Different types of utensils, like steel, brass aluminum, Tin/Iron, Plastic and earthen ware are possessed by 98 per cent, 58 per cent, 89 per cent, 81 per cent, 89 per cent and 77 per cent families respectively.

About 10 per cent family's rear cow/buffalo while about 1.3 per cent is rearing Goat and sheep. About 6 per cent families maintain poultry.

## **6.8 POSSESSION OF ASSETS AND VALUABLE GOODS**

Table 5.7 presents the details relating to the assets and valuable articles owned by the sample household families and the average value at the time of the survey. These assets have been valuated at the prevailing market prices at the time of survey.

The survey results reveal that in Vapi stratum about 50 per cent of families possessed land with an average value of Rs.1,65,390 per reporting family, 90 per cent of household families have building/houses with an average value of Rs.58,378 per reporting family. Further, about 58 per cent of family possessing assets in the form of Jewellery and ornaments, with an average value of Rs.8491 per reporting family whereas the percentage of families having Provident fund to their account is about 77 per cent, with an average amount per reporting family is Rs.49370. About 11 per cent and 88 per cent families, with an average value of Rs.7477 and 6081, possessed livestock and bank balance including cash in hand respectively. Orchard is maintained by about 0.4 per cent families with an average value of Rs.50,000.

In Valsad, about 25 per cent of household families are possessing land with as average value of Rs.1,38,667 per reporting family, about 95 per cent of families have building/houses and 13.2 per cent of families have live stock with an average value of Rs.67,595 and Rs.11,405 per reporting family respectively. Possession of Jewellery and ornaments is reported by about 78 per cent of families with an average value of Rs.9714 per reporting family. About 72 per cent and 65 per cent of household families with an average balance of Rs.7975 and Rs.23089 per reporting family respectively reported bank balance and Provident fund accounts.

In Navsari, 99 per cent of household families possess house with an average value of Rs.57027 per reporting family and 63 per cent families have bank balance with an average amount of Rs.7469 as the balance per reporting family, whereas the percentage of families having provident fund account is about 49 per cent with an average balance of Rs.72760 per reporting family. 11.7 per cent families with an average value of Rs.5015 per reporting family possess jewellery and ornaments. The percentage of families reporting agriculture land and live stock is about 8 per cent and about 2 per cent with an average value of Rs.80,000 and Rs.24,500 per reporting family respectively.

In Sachin stratum Agriculture land is possessed by about 15 per cent of families with its average value per reporting comes out to be Rs.131176, while the Building/Houses are possessed by about 47 per cent families with an average value per reporting family is Rs.52221. Jewellery and ornaments, bank balance and provident fund balance is reported by about 38 per cent, 67 per cent and 29 per cent respectively, with an average value of Rs.6202, Rs.5136 and Rs.19302 respectively.

Taking all the strata together, about 30 per cent of families of households covered during the course of the survey have agriculture land with an average value of Rs.152097 per reporting family and about 85 per cent of the households have houses with an average value of Rs.60224 per reporting family. About 76 per cent families have bank balance and 60 per cent families have provident fund balance on their account with an average value of balance of Rs.6622 and Rs.42657. Further, 52 per cent families have jewellery and ornaments of an average value of Rs.8549, whereas livestock and orchards are maintained by about 8 per cent and 0.2 per cent families with an average value of Rs.9508 and Rs.50000 per reporting family respectively. The average value of per Scheduled Tribe households is Rs.1.33 lakhs.

## **6.9 DISTRIBUTION OF HOUSEHOLDS BY SAVINGS**

The difference between the average monthly income and expenditure reflects the budgetary position of a family. This budgetary gap may be in surplus or in deficit. The surplus gap is known as savings and negative gap known as deficit budget or borrowing. Table 6.7 shows the percentage of household families having propensity to save money.

In Vapi stratum, out of the total 238 households about 88 per cent of workers save money. Out of this about 72 per cent workers keep their saving in banks, about 27 per cent keep their saving at home, about 1 per cent keep their savings with Sahukar, while only 0.5 per cent put their savings in some co-

operative society. The average monthly saving per household comes to be Rs.1359.

In Valsad stratum, about 58 per cent families save money with an average monthly saving of Rs.463 per reporting family. Out of these families 83 per cent households keep their saving in banks and about 10 per cent keep their savings at home whereas 5.2 per cent prefer to keep their saving in some cooperative credit society, while only 1 per cent households keep their saving with Sahukar.

In Navsari, about 68 per cent household families save money with an average monthly saving per household, Rs.1845.59. Out of these, about 52 per cent households keep their saving in bank. None reported keeping saving with Sahukar.

In Sachin, about 73 per cent household families save money with an average monthly saving per household of Rs.1579.73. Out of these families, about 68 per cent keep their saving in Banks, about 31 per cent keep at home and the remaining 1 per cent keep their saving with the Sahukar.

At aggregate level, out of a total stream of 627 household families, (461) about 73.5 per cent save money with an average saving per household worked out to be Rs.1290.35. Out of these families about 70 per cent keep saving in bank, 27 per cent at whereas about 2 per cent families put saving in some Co-operative society while only 1 per cent were keeping their saving with Sahukar.
